A LETTER FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Patriot -

It seems just like yesterday, I was sitting down to reflect on the first year of the *American Freedom Fund* (AFF) and how much this group of young men and women had accomplished in just 12 months. Today, the AFF team's spirit is stronger than ever, and the energy that our leadership, advisory board and volunteers bring to the table each day is nothing short of amazing. Together, we have grown to exceed all of our goals from last year and continue to enrich the lives of our active duty, reserve, and separated service members and their families in everything we do.

The cornerstone of our athletics program, *Patriots* Softball, has continued its momentum of success for a fourth year by empowering more than **80 veteran athletes** and **5 independent teams, providing** an opportunity for these heroes to connect and compete at tournaments in more than <u>10 states</u>. In 2018, we fielded two teams at the USSSA Military Softball Worlds Tournament in Coco Beach, FL, where we finished in the **top 10 nationwide**. The continued

support of our donors and sponsors has provided not only an opportunity for these athletes to compete, but also has covered the registration fees, uniforms and much needed equipment for participating athletes, many of whom would not have been able to participate without such tremendous support.

I am also very proud of the strides that the *Patriots Shooting Team* made in its second year of competition, thanks to the essential funding and support our sponsors provided by helping us to send our Veterans to nationally recognized marksman and snipers competitions. The success of the *Patriots Shooting Team*



program gained national attention, and laid the foundation for our team to educate others, compete and bond at events on both coasts of the country. In fact, at the University of Washington VIBE Inaugural Trap competition, our *Patriots* brought home the awards for first, second and Top Gun.



In 2018, AFF also hosted at least one event a month that brought our Veterans and their families together for the opportunity to socialize, make new friends and build a greater sense of community. Many of these events, like the Remember Everyone Deployed (R.E.D.) Friday Socials, allowed us to partner with some amazing allies in the VSO arena as we continue to build a collaborative and all-inclusive Veteran community.

Finally, AFF's *Manhattans, Martinis & Mistletoe Veterans Awards Gala* kept up with tradition as the signature event of the holiday season. In its 5th year in 2018, we were honored to have 35



Members of Congress serve, in a true bipartisan spirit, as Honorary Co-Chairs of the event, and to have <u>more than</u> <u>400 Patriots gather</u> to celebrate the courage and service of our men and women in uniform. It was an amazing evening hosted by Graham Allen, with attendance by celebrities, Members of Congress, and military leaders from

across the region. In keeping with our mission focus to support and collaborate, and through the support of sponsors and ticket sales, we recognized the impact made by three veteran-focused organizations, along with grants awarded to each organization. The 2018 Patriot Awards recognized the outstanding community service of the Maryland Gold Star Mothers, the Chris Kyle Frog Foundation and Team ADDO.

As we turn the page to 2019, I am extremely excited by what lies ahead for AFF, as each of our current programs continue to grow, and new programs come online to empower and enrich our Veteran community. I am personally excited about two of these programs: *Headshots* and *Patriot Outdoors*. Through a partnership with Team ADDO, *Headshots* has a goal of helping 1000+ transitioning servicemembers and their spouses, across the country, find their next adventure and sense of purpose in the civilian world by offering complementary professional headshots and mentorship. Speaking of adventure, *Patriots Outdoors* will launch this year with a full schedule of rock climbing, kayaking and camping for adaptive and non-adaptive outdoor aficionados.

As AFF closes the chapter on another year, I cannot express my gratitude enough to all of those fellow *patriots* who attend the planning meetings, volunteer long hours and are there no matter what the conditions to support our nation's heroes. To the many sponsors and corporate partners who have raised their hands in support, and pledged their time and resources, please know that we could not sustain our mission to serve to those who have served by our side **without you**.

I could not be prouder of what this small army of volunteers has accomplished in such a short time. They are truly the epitome of the *American spirit* – a spirit and drive that inspires us to
