

After their individual tours of duty, they sought a way to continue serving their brothers and sisters in arms by providing the Veteran community the opportunity; the means to maintain the fellowship and the support of the military as they transition towards their next career.

AFF empowers Active Duty, Reserve, and Separated Service Members through a mission of athletics, education, and advocacy. During 2020 and 2021, like a number of our peers, AFF suffered as many of our events across the country were canceled. Nevertheless, our incredible members, supporters, and allies found ways to stay connected and continue at a scale acceptable within local guidelines. RED Fridays often became small gatherings at a member's home or in their backyard. In some areas, the Patriot Softball teams found a way to stay connected through the formation of a disc golf league and competition went virtual through online gaming.
